A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF LONGVIEW, WASHINGTON REVISING  
THE ARCHIE ANDERSON PARK MASTER PLAN

---

WHEREAS, by Council Resolution No. 1983 the City Council of the City of Longview adopted the Archie Anderson Park Master Plan to contribute to the orderly development of the park; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1983 recognized that the park master plan would be developed over a number of years and “needs to be flexible to best represent the needs of the community at the time of the development phases”; and

WHEREAS, conceptual plans have been prepared under the auspices of a CDBG planning grant and recently presented to the City Council for a Highlands Neighborhood community center to be located in Archie Anderson Park. The master plan for the park that was adopted by the council two years ago also showed a community center, but in a different location and about half the size of what is envisioned in the more recent plans; and

WHEREAS, the “displaced” neighborhood garden and orchard shown on the original master plan is being and would be provided at the Carolina Street garden site and across 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue from the park at the Highlands Neighborhood Association’s neighborhood center house site. The playground would be moved to another location in the park, and the restroom would be incorporated into the newly planned community center. The new center does not affect youth baseball facilities as shown in the park plan; and

WHEREAS, the Parks & Recreation Board has reviewed and endorsed the recent conceptual design for the community center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Longview as follows:

Section 1. The Archie Anderson Park Master Plan, as adopted by Resolution No. 1983 is hereby amended as shown in the attached 2013 Proposed Community

Center Site Plan, provided that, as previously, nothing in this plan shall preclude the acquisition of adjacent property for the expansion of the park.
