## Lake Sacajawea Park Preservation Plan

The City of Longview is developing a Park Preservation Plan for Lake Sacajawea Park and would like your input. Please join us at one of our public workshops and give us your opinions on how you think the park should be preserved for future generations.

### What is a Preservation Plan?

A Preservation Plan is a planning tool required by the Washington State Department of Archaeology and Historic Preservation for parks and districts listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Development of the plan includes an inventory of physical features and history of the park, identification of character-defining features key to preservation of the park's history, and recommendations for preservation of those features.

### How is a Preservation Plan used?

The plan serves as a decision-making tool to guide stewardship decisions for retention of historic features while sustaining vibrant community use.

### What will happen at the workshops?


