

Project Background: Process and Timeline

1. Lake Sacajawea Park listed on National Register of Historic Places
2. Project in ROW adjacent to Park at Ocean Beach Highway using federal funds triggers Preservation Plan process
3. Development of Park Preservation Plan:
 - a. Identification
 - b. Evaluation
 - c. Stewardship
 - d. Supplemental Material
4. Park Preservation Plan Approval:
 - a. Preliminary DAHP review
 - b. City of Longview and local Historic Preservation Commission
 - c. Final DAHP review
5. Plan in place to guide future decisions concerning Lake Sacajawea Park

Project Introduction: The Park Preservation Plan

What is a Preservation Plan?

A Preservation Plan is a planning tool used to guide future work that is required by the Washington State Department of Archeology and Historic Preservation (DAHP) for parks and districts listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Project Introduction: The Park Preservation Plan

Development of the Preservation Plan includes elements:

- 1. *Identification:*** taking inventory of the physical features and history of the Park
- 2. *Evaluation:*** determination of character-defining features key to the preservation of the Park
- 3. *Stewardship:*** creation of a mechanism for appropriately managing the Park
- 4. *Supplemental Material:*** organization of documents and photos for reference when making management decisions












