AN UPDATE FOR LONGVIEW CITIZENS

R.A. Long Park "Master Plan" Open House

The City of Longview will be conducting several workshops over the next few months to develop a master plan for R. A. Long Park and the Civic Center. The City previously retained a firm to identify Longview's attractions and assets. Recently, local citizens on the Community Assessment Action Team evaluated the identified assets and recommended that renovating and improving R.A. Long Park become a top city council priority. In addition, the City received a federal grant to improve motorist and pedestrian safety around the Civic Center. To ensure that all park and street improvements are compatible, the City will prepare a long-range master plan for R.A. Long Park and the Civic Center.

The plan will take into account historic and cultural elements as well as general design concepts for the park. Community input, combined with traffic and pedestrian studies, will help us determine the best long-range plan for the park.

Join us at these important workshops and give us your opinions on how you think the park should be used and developed for future generations.
