TREE BOARD REPORT

- Removed 11 trees
- Machine ground 5 stumps
- Chipped brush and removed trees at Golf course
- Completed 9 site updates/inspections
- Responded to 1 afterhours calls
- Pruned 627 trees
- Began crown elevations and suckering of trees throughout Go 4th areas
- Water truck, gator bags and hand watering has started
- Received assistance from WCC crew for 2 weeks
- WCC crew assisted with blackberry removal at Mt Solo trail
- WCC crew suckered and structure pruned 600 small trees
- Delivered chips to 3 school gardens

PARKS BOARD REPORT

- Completed 692 Work Orders for the period
- Top dressed and over seeded areas at new Archie Anderson playground
- All automated irrigation systems have been inspected and are now set to water through night
- Have started edging and weed whipping and mulch application of all Go 4th areas
- Mowing routes continue heavy
- A slide at Roy Morse and one at 7th Ave damaged and have been ordered
- Vandalism costs of \$11,438 for this period
- Cleaned 2 major homeless camps at Lake and 7th Ave
- Collected 9 sharps from Park locations
- All playgrounds have been top dressed with cushioning material (820 cu yards)
- Repaired vandalized drinking fountain and Rhody bed fence
- Weed control continues, spot and boom spraying larger areas
- Installed additional color at City Hall beds
- Installed hanging baskets at City Hall
- Installed hanging baskets along Commerce and set irrigation
- All Go 4th signage and fencing out of storage and inspected
- 4th of July banners installed around Lake
- Lake path has received gravel touch up
- Repaired damage to Garden plots irrigation lines
- Ribbon cutting and opening of new Archie Anderson playground
- Edged temporary transit station location
- Rough mowed 3rd Ave, Regency, Canyon Pl. and the Nursery
- Completed recertification of 1 Playground Safety inspector
- 3 staff certified in irrigation system troubleshooting and design
- Mole population at many of the Parks continues to thrive
- Continue to prepare softball fields for summer leagues 6 days a week
- Prepared for 3 softball tournaments this period
- Pressure washed playgrounds and fishing docks at lake Sacajawea
